English:

For English we will be focusing on Goldilocks and the 3 Bears. Children will arrive to school where a thief has been into school and caused havoc in the Foundation classrooms. The children will use clues, make wanted posters and interview a suspect.

The children will use this as a stimulus about how to catch a porridge thief and write instructions.

The children will then learn the story of Goldilocks and the Three Bears before innovating to write their own version by changing the characters.



Maths:

The children are going to be focusing on the numbers 10-20. They are going to be looking at representing numbers using a range of manipulatives.

The children will be finding one more and one less than teen numbers and begin adding and subtracting by counting on and counting back.

Towards then end of half term, we will be focusing on shape, naming 2D and 3D shapes, and describing them using words such as vertices, edges and faces.



<u>PE</u>

From Spring 2, children should come to school in their PE kits on the days they have PE. This is to increase the time children are spent in the actual PE lesson.

Reading in Foundation

We continue to promote reading at Broughton Fields as one of those essential skills that all children need in order to support their learning in all areas of the curriculum.

At home, we continue to advise that you read to your child on a daily basis to improve their fluency and comprehension skills.

At school, the children are assessed against their 'bookmarks'. It is important that you are practising the words on their bookmarks at home and that children are able to read these words on sight. This will

support the children's ability to read with fluency.
