Spring 1 Topic - Kings and Queens

English

In Year 1, the children will be learning the story of 'Sleeping Beauty'. The children will then innovate the story in order to retell and write their own royal themed story.

Year 2 will be continuing their Meerkat Mail work by learning about the structure and content of non-chronological reports. The children will be learning a non-chronological report about meerkats. They will then be making up their own animals and writing a non-chronological report about it.

Maths

Year 1 will continue working with numbers to 100 and identifying the value of each digit in a 2-digit number. Your child will then move onto learning about multiplication and division using our knowledge of counting in 2s, 5s and 10s.

Year 2 will be learning how to solve division calculations using sharing and grouping as well as using their multiplication facts. The children will then use these skills to solve problems to find fractions of shapes and amounts.

Computing



In Year 1, the children are going to be exploring a range of educational apps on the iPads. They are going to learn how to use the apps in different areas of the curriculum to support their learning.

Year 2 are going to learn how to use Scratch Junior in order to create their own story. This will involve the children programming characters to retell a story of their choice. The children will learn about algorithms and debugging when mistakes are made. Scratch Junior is a free app that can be downloaded onto your devices at home.

Science

In Science, both year groups are going to learn about materials. In Year 1, the children will be learning about the properties of different materials and use this knowledge to group everyday objects. Year 2 will build on their Year 1 knowledge and discuss the specific uses of different materials and why they are used.

Design Technology

Both year groups will be making puppets next half term. The children will be designing and making a puppet based on a member of the Royal Family. Your child will be learning the skill of designing, cutting, sewing and evaluating their product.

History

During Spring 1, the children are going to be learning about famous British monarchs throughout history.

The children will be learning lots of interesting facts about Henry VIII, George VI and Queen Elizabeth II as well as finding out about the future monarchs.



Royal Ball

To finish our Kings and Queens topic, we will be having a Royal banquet and ball on **Wednesday 13th February 2019**. On this day, your child can come to school dressed as a king, queen, princess or prince. The children will be doing fun activities in the morning before having a royal themed banquet and ball in the hall in the afternoon.
