Year 3 will be writing a letter to MK Council about current environmental issues. We will be learn- ing to use persuasive language and extend our ideas. This term the Anglo Sax- ons have landed! We will learn about why they came to Britain and An- glo Saxon Life. We will learn about King Alfred and King Arthur as well as ancient burial site of Sutton Hoo and it's treasures. The Bayeux Tapestry will be use to as a source of evidence from the past.	We will be exploring and creating work based on the famous artists: Andy Goldsworthy, Henri Matisse, Wassily Kandinsky and Roy Lichtenstein.	Year 3 and 4 will be developing their skills in athletics including pac- ing themselves to run over long and short distances as well as a range of throwing and jumping skills. We will challenge ourselves to beat previous records and compete with each other.
<u>Music</u> Year 3 will explore the pentatonic scale through traditional Chinese music. Year 4 will learn to play popular songs using the virtual guitar on Garageband.	<b>French</b> Summer term will involve lots of animals in LKS2. Year 3 will be learning a story about 4 animal friends who are desperate to eat a big red apple. Year 4 will be studying "The Carnival of the Animals" by Camille Saint Saens and finding out how animals com- municate in French!
